Dear Parents:

**School starts Thursday, August 11, 2011** and we are looking forward to another great year. This will be a normal full day. First bell rings at **8:05 A.M.** and the end of day bell will ring at **3:20 P.M.**

Those of you in need of transportation services, please call the office by Monday, August 1, 2011. The bus will run the same route as last year starting in Wilcox County and stopping at Pinecrest Baptist Church (parking lot) with return route in the afternoon.

Our financial office would like to remind you that all tuition and fees must be current **before the first day of school.** Your monthly tuition and bus fee payments are due by the 10th of each month. This is a must for us to have the funds we need to keep our school running smoothly.

We would like to remind you that the \$200.00 per child book/computer fee in grades K5 thru 12 is due on or before the first day of school. Please note that your annual building fund payment is due no later than January 1, 2012.

New students entering Crisp Academy in K5 through 12th grade will need to present a certified copy of his birth certificate to be copied for school records, a current immunization certificate (State Form 3231), and a Hearing, Vision & Dental Screening (State Form 3300). K3 and K4 students will also need to present a certified copy of their birth certificate and a current immunization certificate (State form 3231). These forms can be obtained at your local health department. These are mandated by Georgia Law. **Beginning with the 1994-95 school year, a second dose of MMR vaccine is required for entrance into the 6th grade in all Georgia schools, and as of 2002 all rising sixth graders are required to have the varicella vaccine or show proof of having had chicken pox. Since the 1997-98 school year, Kindergarten students born after January 1, 1992, must complete the hepatitis B series before entering school. Please see enclosed letter for information from the Health Dept. regarding Prevnar 13.**

**Lunch will be served the first day of school as this is a full day and dismissal will be at 3:20 PM.** The lunchroom will be open and your child will have the choice of eating in the lunchroom or bringing a lunch from home. Parents should note that the Parent-Student Handbook states specific procedures concerning late arrivals and early check-outs. Parents should familiarize themselves with these procedures.

Please see the attached sheet for additional important information. We are looking forward to serving you in 2011-2012 and appreciate your support in all matters concerning Crisp Academy and your child's education. **Open House will be from 5:30 - 7:00 on Wednesday, August 10.** We hope to see you here.
